What is a Gap Year?

A Gap Year is an experiential semester or year "off," typically taken between high school and college or university in order to deepen practical, professional, and personal awareness. In fact, in a recent study, one of the two biggest reasons students chose to take a Gap Year was precisely to address academic burnout. https://gapyearassociation.org/gap-year.php

If posted OUTCAN prior to taking a Gap Year, a dependent child should move to the new post (initially, even if they do not remain there for their Gap Year) in order to be eligible for educational allowances upon return to academic institution post-Gap Year while parent is still at post.
