Introduction

This booklet has been put together to provide assistance to military members and their families when they are posted to Central Saskatchewan Detachment Dundurn. The Central Saskatchewan Military Family Resource Centre's mission is:

To promote healthy families, for those who share in the unique experiences of military life, by advocating or providing programs or services.

This is our first step in helping to fulfill our mission, and we sincerely hope that throughout your posting here you look to *your* Resource Centre as a means of improving your quality of life in your new location. This package has also been revised by military members and families who have arrived before you and have helped shape the information within this package, as our goal is to provide useful and helpful information when on the move.

Our Area of Responsibility:

The majority of the postings within this geographical area are for 17 Wing Detachment Dundurn; however, there are several units within the City of Saskatoon, and a unit in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan. As a result, the majority of this information is directed to those members and families that will be residing in Dundurn and area and in Saskatoon. If you are posted to Prince Albert or choose to live in a small town or rural area not covered in this booklet, please contact us, and we will gather some information and have it forwarded to you as soon as possible.

Integrated Relocation Program (IRP)

The Integrated Relocation Program (IRP) was first introduced on 1 April 1999 and, as promised, it has offered a more "customized fit" for CF members.

Once a posting message is received, CF members will be directed to a relocation consultant who will guide their move from beginning to end. The counselor will provide members with a relocation package; a destination guide will help members to assess options that are in their best interest. **The IRP representative for Detachment Dundurn is located at 15 Wing CFB Moose Jaw 306-694-2251**

Orientation to Detachment and Local Services

Detachment Dundurn is situated 35 km south of Saskatoon, 5 km off Highway No. 11 to Regina (300 km). The Detachment is 5 km north of the small town of Dundurn (population approximately 550). Services in Dundurn are limited (no bank or large grocery store) although Dundurn does have a small grocery the F4 Family store, gas station, post office, arena, ATM services, two restaurants, elementary school, several churches and some other basic services. There are 28 PMQs on the Detachment, a church that currently offers Roman Catholic services, a playground, a gym, your family resource centre, and several clubs (see a further section in this document). The CSMFRC Inc. has a fabulous resource library of videos and books. Drop by the Centre and check it out!

Saskatoon - Orientation

Saskatoon is built on both sides of the South Saskatchewan River, which runs from the southwest to northeast. The side of the river closest to the Detachment is referred to as the “east side” by Saskatonians. Saskatoon is Saskatchewan’s largest city with a population of 236,797 and growing.

Traveling north on Highway No. 11 from the Detachment, any point in the city can be quickly reached by taking Circle Drive, the Idylwyld freeway, 8th Street, College Drive, or 22nd Street. Five bridges cross the river; the two largest (having divided traffic lanes) are the Idylwyld “freeway” Bridge and the Circle Drive Bridge. The three smaller, downtown bridges are the Victoria Bridge (the Iron Bridge), Broadway Bridge, and University Bridge. *Avenues* in Saskatoon generally run north and south, while *streets* usually run east and west.

Saskatchewan Government Insurance (SGI) is the principal vehicle insurer in Saskatchewan. You should have received an SGI pamphlet with this booklet that outlines Saskatchewan’s vehicle registration and insurance program. **All vehicles previously licensed in another province must pass a mandatory vehicle inspection before SGI will insure your vehicle.**

It is recommended that you obtain a driver’s abstract and a claims-free letter from your current insurance company prior to your arrival in Saskatchewan (this may qualify you for a discount up to 10 percent). You may wish to ask your current provider for a letter of good standing to help reduce cost when applicable & wait time for discounts.

Information brochures and registration forms are available at the MFRC office on base bldg #100. Forms must be mailed in with two pieces of identification. Saskatchewan Health benefits will be provided on the first day of the third calendar month following the date you moved to Saskatchewan. You will have no interruption in health benefits as your previous province will cover you until your Saskatchewan benefits take effect ... with the exception of Quebec residents (Next para applies).

Quebec Exception: Saskatchewan Health benefits will be provided on the first day of the third calendar month following the date you moved to Saskatchewan. Quebec Health will provide coverage until your Saskatchewan Health goes into effect (some limitations apply). Quebec Health encourages residents to notify their office when they will be moving outside the province. Should you need to access medical services prior to receiving your Saskatchewan Health coverage, you may have to submit cash payment to a medical clinic for the service

provided. You will then be required to complete the necessary documentation to receive reimbursement from Quebec Health. Please note that you will only be reimbursed at Quebec rates for the same service. If you seek medical assistance from an emergency room in a hospital, your Quebec Health card will be accepted and the hospital will seek direct payment from Quebec Health (without demanding cash payment for services). You may be required to reimburse the hospital for any amount that exceeds the Quebec rate for the services provided. See <http://www.ramq.gouv.qc.ca/>

Fire Sirens

In the event of a fire, fire drill or triggered alarm at CFAD Dundurn, a very loud and long air raid siren will sound. The siren will continue to warn all personnel of a potential fire. All CFAD Dundurn personnel are to report immediately to the Depot and all designated Detachment Dundurn personnel are to report to the Fire Hall. If additional assistance is required, the siren will again sound a loud and undulating warning. Once the fire is extinguished, a false alarm detected, or the drill is completed, the siren will sound a short blast to indicate the "all clear" signal.

The siren will also sound a short burst every weekday at 0945 to signal a operation test.

Detonation

CFAD Dundurn conducts ammunition destruction operations on the Detachment from May - October each year. It is common to hear loud explosions each weekday during these months. Normally CFAD Dundurn conducts set-up procedures during the morning with large explosions after lunch. From time to time the explosions may start early and continue throughout the day.

Pets/Veterinarians

Dundurn does not have a local veterinarian, although Saskatoon has many to choose from. Once a year in April/May, a pet immunization clinic is held in the town of Dundurn. Contact Cindy Krawchuck at 492-4857.

The City Saskatoon and Town of Dundurn require all dogs and cats to be licensed.

The following are the regulations regarding pets at Detachment Dundurn, the Town of Dundurn and Saskatoon:

- All pets must be immunized on a yearly basis.
- All pets are to be leashed at all times.

- A “Poop and Scoop” order is in effect.
- The Detachment regulates pets according to CFHA Para 69; the Town of Dundurn allows three pets. There is no limit on pets per household in Saskatoon.
- Failure to comply could result in the owner being fined.

If someone in your family is seeking employment, gather up your résumé, update it if possible (...if not, send it anyway ...and any additional information) and fax it to us at (306) 492-2051 or submit a contact request via our website at www.csmfrc.com. If someone in your family is (or will be) receiving EI benefits, be prepared for a delay during the time that your file is transferred to the Saskatoon office. You can attempt to minimize problems by discussing your relocation with an EI counselor in your present location, by completing the change-of-address part of the EI benefits card return envelope as soon as you establish a new address, and by verifying with an EI counselor in Saskatoon that your file has been transferred.

Unique things about Saskatchewan

- **Saskatchewan is on Central Standard Time year round.** This means that we never change our clocks. In the winter months we are the same time as Manitoba and in the summer months the same time as Alberta.
- **Each province has different restrictions and traffic laws.** For example, radar-detecting systems are permitted in some provinces (such as Saskatchewan), but not in others. As well, Saskatchewan has restrictions regarding non-factory tinted windows on your vehicles. (Please see www.iwfa.com/iwfa/Consumer_Info/auto_province_laws.html for clarification.) Should you have any questions or concerns regarding vehicle restrictions and traffic laws, please contact your provincial police department.
- **Employees get a minimum of three weeks' annual holidays after each year of employment.** (Minimum wage is \$8.60/hr) May 1st 2009 it will be going up to \$9.25.
- **Saskatchewan became a province of Canada in 1905** and is now home to over 1,000,000 people with 76 percent of the population in urban centres and 24 percent in rural areas.
- **Saskatchewan is Canada's "sunniest" province**, averaging from 2000 to 2500 hours of sunshine annually.
